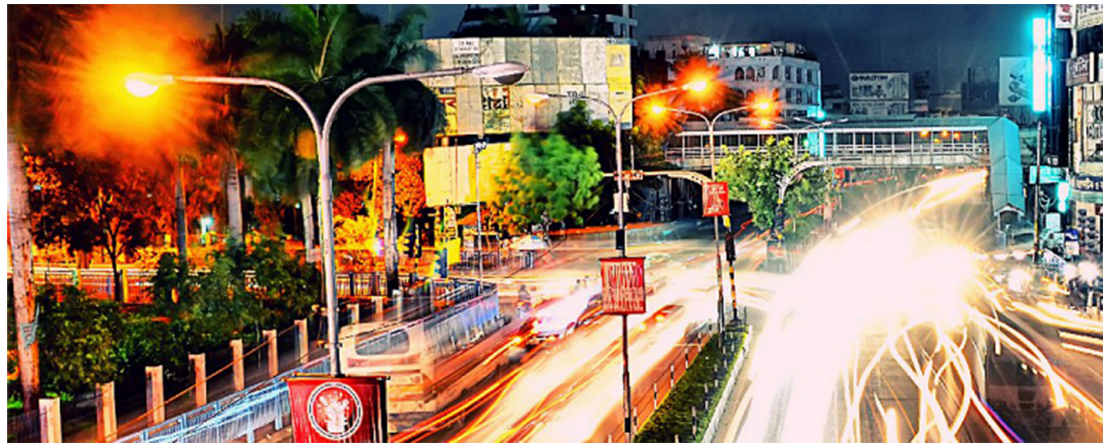

Implementing merchant descriptors requires software development skills. You must write code that uses the API request fields to include merchant descriptor fields in credit card service requests.

Barclays Merchant Descriptors

This feature enables you to submit merchant descriptor values that appear on a cardholder's statement.

Before including merchant descriptors in your requests, you must be boarded to the Barclays multi-currency platform.
