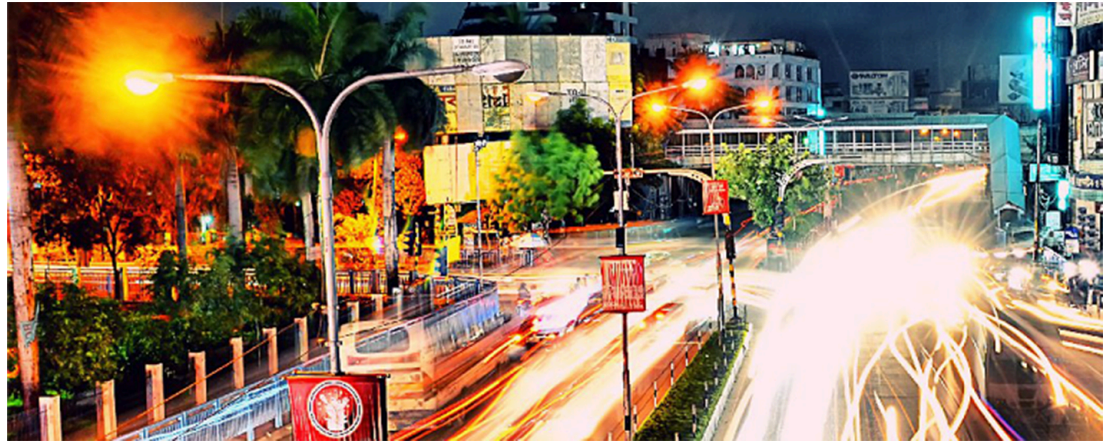

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# General Information

These release notes cover all releases to the production server for the week ending April 1, 2022.

# Announcements

**Warning:** Passing six-digit BINs can result in no match being generated when there are multiple possible matches. We recommend that you update your systems to pass eight-digit BINs as soon as possible.

## Bug Identified in REST Response Field

When submitting the **processinformation.authorizationOptions.initiator.credentialStoredOnFile** REST field to the `/tss/v3/transactions/{id}` endpoint, the possible values are Y or N, not the expected True or False. The issue is under investigation and a fix will be provided soon.

## Internet Explorer 11 No Longer Supported

The Business Center no longer supports Internet Explorer 11. Business Center users should update their browsers. See the [Support Center article on supported web browsers](#) for more details.

## Bank Identification Number (BIN) Checking Not Supported for Network Tokens

At this time, PaRC does not support BIN classification on network tokens. Because BIN classification and BIN check are unavailable, network token transactions follow these rules:

- All network token transactions are treated as domestic transactions.
- All network tokens default to the domestic credit card type.
- No validation occurs on wallet load funding if an international network token is processed.
- No blocking is possible for debit or prepaid transactions because all network tokens are treated as the credit card type.
- Network tokens without BIN classification have no effect on the E-Commerce Indicator (ECI) classification function.

Customers will be notified when the Cybersource BIN Lookup Service becomes available for network tokens.

# Features Introduced This Week

- [RM-14001] Credit Mutuel-CIC, BNP Paribas, and Banque de France and Tresor Public can now be configured through the Card Processing Configuration API.
- [RM-14219] Welcome emails sent from the new boarding platform now support branding theme elements such as email alias, email signature, logo, and cobranded URL.
- [RM-14344] Merchant descriptor data is now copied from the registration page to the Card Processing Processor pages, making it available for processors.
- [RM-14372] Transaction Reference Numbers are now set when requesting charge and refund endpoints in the Technology Partner Adapter.
- [RM-14545] The Payment Account Reference and Authorization Payment Account Reference order elements are now comparable to each other.
- [RM-14734] The HSBC gateway now supports Strong Customer Authentication exemptions.

# Fixed Issues

- [RM-14344] For FDC Nashville, the helper text is no longer treated as default values.
- [RM-14357] Report counts for the Risk Score Distribution Report, Order Conversion Summary, and Profile Rule Performance System Reports are now correct when the user's timezone is different from the account's timezone, or when the merchant is using the Sao Paulo timezone.
