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General Information

These release notes cover all releases to the production server for the week ending July 1, 2022.

Announcements

Warning: Passing six-digit BINs can result in no match being generated when there are multiple possible matches. We recommend that you update your systems to pass eight-digit BINs as soon as possible.

Partner Risk Controls support for BIN classification

At this time, Partner Risk Controls only supports BIN classification on network tokens for Visa, Mastercard, and Discover cards. All other types of card transactions will continue to follow these rules:

- All network token transactions are treated as domestic transactions.
- All network tokens default to the domestic credit card type.
- No validation occurs on wallet load funding if an international network token is processed.
- No blocking is possible for debit or prepaid transactions because all network tokens are treated as the credit card type.
- Network tokens without BIN classification have no effect on the electronic commerce indicator (ECI) classification function.

Customers will be notified when the BIN Lookup Service recognizes network tokens for the other cards.

Features Introduced This Week

- [RM-13566] Customers can now see new response fields related to velocity count in the REST and Simple Order APIs.
- [RM-13850] When the BIN Lookup Service cannot determine the issuer BIN, a new information code, "UNV-BIN", now occurs. The code can be used in Rule Builder. When "UNV-BIN" is present for a transaction, the BIN is not applied to Decision Manager rules and velocity, and the BIN is not returned in the Decision Manager response.
- [RM-14341] The JCN gateway now supports 3-D Secure 2 transactions for Discover, Diners Club, and American Express.
- [RM-14426] Two new API fields, `paymentInsightsInformation.responseInsights.category` and `paymentInsightsInformation.responseInsights.categoryCode`, are added to give merchants more details about decline reasons.
- [RM-14783] The eCheck application now supports up to five owners. For US customers, eCheck is restricted to acquiring mode.
- [RM-15215] Standalone credits now may be sent to Prosa.
- [RM-15789] To comply with the Second Payment Services Directive, all non-exempted transactions are now specified to require a step up.
- [RM-15917] The Case Details page in the Business Center now indicates whether a transaction requires a step up.

Fixed Issues

- [RM-15643] In Decision Manager, reject rules added earlier are not overridden by accept rules added later.
- [RM-15674] CP12 TCR 1 positions 52-70 are now populated with spaces if the fields are unused.
- [RM-16233] The REST API now returns the correct status message when customer authentication is required.
