Cybersource through VisaNet Rebranding

The Cybersource through VisaNet product is now called *Visa Platform Connect*.

Gateway End-Of-Life Announcement

The American Express Brighton and Omnipay Ireland gateways will reach the end of their service in November 2021. Future processing on these gateways cannot be guaranteed. If you have follow-on updates or corrections to make for transactions on either gateway, it is advised that you make the updates or corrections as soon as possible.

Features Introduced This Week

- [RM-10470] A new Unified Checkout endpoint, /confirmations, is exposed so merchants can notify Secure Remote Commerce (SRC) networks about the usage of SRC released payment credentials.
- [RM-10623] Portfolio managers can now create templates and configurations for their merchants through the Decision Manager API.
- [RM-11124] The Business Center now supports configurations and merchant attributes for the Paymentech Tampa processor.
- [RM-11170] The echeck service is available through self-enablement only.
- [RM-12229] Merchants can now search for transactions up to 12 months old.
- [RM-12231] Merchants can enable echeck processing through the Business Center.
- [RM-12247] The reconciliation reference number is now displayed in the Business Center's Transaction Search and Details page and is available through the Transaction Details API.
- [RM-12555] On the Business Center subscription page, the "BinNumber" field is re-labeled as "AccountPrefix" in several reports, with the description, "First four digits of customer's payment account number."
- [RM-12560] Merchants can now create subscriptions directly from the subscriptions dashboard in the Business Center. Merchants can choose to search for an existing customer or create a new customer to create the subscription.
- [RM-12586] The ValueLink OGS gateway can use the Key Management Service API for running EAN-enabled transactions for activation, balance inquiry, redemption, refund, and reload services.
- [RM-12590] Unified Checkout can now load scripts and iframes on Pay By Link payment pages.
- [RM-12604] The Common Transaction Processing API has a number of new features, including support for installments, AVS, the Customer Notification Service, and MC Tax ID.
- [RM-12607] A new first-class REST service to support an inquiry service for installments is released.
- [RM-12629] Customers can now search for transactions with a Digital Payment Method of Visa Network Token (COF) or Mastercard Network Token (COF). When viewing transactions that used a TMS network token, the transaction displays a Digital Payment Method as text rather than as a numerical value.

- [RM-12689] The following gateways are now onboarded to Visa Platform Connect: Wpay Pty. Limited, Metrobank S.A., Live Payments Australia, and KBX Myanmar. In addition, new currencies are added to Sacombank.
- [RM-12867] The following acquirers now receive CP01 TCR9 files as part of Visa's October Biannual Enhancement Release: HDFC Bank Ltd., Yes Bank Ltd. (Mumbai), Global Payments Limited, Axis Bank, and ICICI Bank.
- [RM-8195] Key Refresh and PIN Translate capabilities are now added to Visa Platform Connect processors.

Fixed Issues

- [RM-12470] When taking an organization's status to Live/Test/Inactive, if the organization's parent does not satisfy OMS's hierarchy rules, the user is shown a dialog that displays up to ten organizations that require a change and that asks the user for permission to make the changes.
- [RM-12612] The TC33A file now passes the 63.1 field in CP01:TCR1, positions 80-83, as expected.
- [RM-12648] Payment Services Directive 2 compliance fixes have been made for the Streamline, HSBC, and Omnipay Direct gateways.
