Announcements

Gateway End-Of-Life Announcement

The American Express Brighton and Omnipay Ireland gateways will reach the end of their service in November 2021. Future processing on these gateways cannot be guaranteed. If you have follow-on updates or corrections to make for transactions on either gateway, it is advised that you make the updates or corrections as soon as possible.

Internet Explorer 11 No Longer Supported

The Business Center no longer supports Internet Explorer 11. Business Center users should update their browsers.

Bank Identification Number (BIN) Checking Not Supported For Network Tokens

At this time, PaRC does not support BIN classification on network tokens. Because BIN classification and BIN check are unavailable, network token transactions follow these rules:

- All network token transactions are treated as domestic transactions.
- All network tokens default to the domestic credit card type.
- No validation occurs on wallet load funding if an international network token is processed.
- No blocking is possible for debit or prepaid transactions because all network tokens are treated as the credit card type.
- Network tokens without BIN classification have no effect on the E-Commerce Indicator (ECI) classification function.

Customers will be notified when the Cybersource BIN Lookup Service becomes available for network tokens.

Features Introduced This Week

- [RM-13287] The PrepareCardForFurtherUsage API now includes payment card details in the response.

Fixed Issues

- [RM-12983] Processor responses now properly map to the proper decline state.
- [RM-13240] The custom date range picker in Case Search now correctly converts from 24-hour time to AM and PM.
- [RM-13296] An issue that resulted in authorization declines from Partner Risk Controls for tokenized transactions is now fixed. Merchants who are not onboarded onto Visa Direct can therefore process tokenized transactions.
